

GOVERNORS' CHARGING POLICY FOR ADDITIONAL ACTIVITIES

The Governors recognise the valuable contribution that the wide range of additional activities, including clubs, can make towards pupils' personal and social education. The Governing Body aims to promote such activities as part of a broad and balanced curriculum for the pupils of the School. There is no obligation for a parent to make a financial contribution and no child will be omitted from any activity taking place during the normal School day. Voluntary contributions to enable such activities to take place will be sought.

As far as possible, School will give notice of forthcoming trips/events and will accept payment in instalments. All activities are linked to areas of the curriculum. The School needs parental co-operation to allow trips and events to go ahead. Should there be insufficient co-operation, trips/events may not go ahead.
