Amount of funding allocated - £8,790

Summary of spending and actions taken:

- Providing an additional swimming teacher for KS2 at Kingsley Pool £2,822
- PE Scheme of Work £600 and equipment to match the scheme £500
- Subscription to School Sport Partnership £200
- Transport for competitions £500
- Playground equipment £4,168

Impact

- 86 children have taken part in swimming this year resulting in 96% of non-swimmers able to swim.
- Staff are now more competent and confident in teaching PE, the new scheme provides a range of activities, music, video clips and assessment which are being used with the children. The school has now improved the quality and range of PE available to children.
- This year we took part in the following competitions: Hockey (Worcestershire School Games), Rugby (Worcestershire School Games), Football (Worcestershire Catholic Sports Partnership), Athletics (Worcestershire Catholic Sports Partnership), Swimming (TBA). We also have the whole of our Year 3 children competing in a MAC sports event at St Augustine's and 10 Year 4 children have been invited to the Worcestershire School Sports finals events (5th July).
- The School Council were involved in selecting the playground equipment. They chose a 'clamber stack' which has now been installed and is accessed by all year groups.
