



## School Games: Worcestershire's Got Talent Competition



The Worcestershire Local Organising Committee (LOC) is running a talent variety competition, 'Worcestershire's Got Talent' which is open to all young people aged 5 – 19 years from schools across Worcestershire.

The competition is part of the Worcestershire School Games programme, which is part of a national programme to motivate and inspire young people to take part in more competitive school sport.

The aim of the competition is to find other talents our young people have with the top 3 individuals/groups winning the opportunity to perform in front of over 1,000 people at the Opening Ceremony of our Worcestershire Winter School Games which takes place on Tuesday 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2015 at the University of Worcester.

The competition is for **dancers, singers, bands, musicians and alternative skills or talents**, and is open to school aged individuals, groups and classes.

To enter you are required to:

- video your talent in action using a video camera or smartphone
- Upload it to YouTube (you will need to create an account if you haven't already got one) or burn it onto CD

The School Games Local Organising Committee (LOC) will select the top 3 acts to perform!

Please note –

- The duration of the performance should be no longer than 3 minutes
- The performer(s) must be able to perform within a limited performance space
- Entrants will be expected to supply their own compatible and appropriate backing music track in advance, wear appropriate performance clothing, bring their own instruments, props etc if needed. You will be responsible for your equipment and ensuring it is safe and suitable for its purpose on the day of the Games
- No profanity or vulgar lyrics in any vocal performance or dance music.
